Sunday 18 May 2025 is an important day in the life of Great St Mary's, when we hold our Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM). The first part is called 'the Vestry Meeting', at which our Churchwardens are elected. Those eligible to vote are those on the Great St Mary's Electoral Roll and anyone who lives within our parish.

The second part is the Annual Parochial Church Meeting, which will be the opportunity to receive the Financial Report for the accounts for 2024 and the Budget for 2025, and to **elect five** members to the Parochial Church Council (PCC). The Annual Review of activities in 2024 will also be available and we will discuss plans for 2025.

The calling notices will be published in the South Porch and in Michaelhouse. Nomination papers for church wardens and PCC members will be available at coffee from Sunday 27 April or by emailing the PCC Secretary, Marion Cobby, at pccsec@gsm.cam.ac.uk. Any person being nominated for the post of PCC member must already be on the Electoral Roll (a copy of which will be displayed in Great St Mary's and at Michaelhouse from 2 May 2025).
